 - WHEREAS, the Board is obligated under state and federal law to adopt model procedures for the education of children with disabilities;
 - WHEREAS, new model procedures recently were published by the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) to bring districts into compliance with the *Operating Standards for Ohio's Schools Serving Children with Disabilities*;
 - THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby rescinds all other versions of model policies and procedures for the education of children with disabilities.
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board hereby adopts Model Procedures for the Education of Children with Disabilities: Model Version #3, published in April 2003.
 - BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Treasurer shall furnish the ODE, Office for Exceptional Children, with a completed copy of the form entitled *Adoption of Model Procedures for the Education of Children with Disabilities*.

- ❖ Awarding a contract to Kevin McGovern & Associates, the successful low bidder for bids received May 9, 2003 for the purchase of two (2) flexible steel water tube boilers and controls for Pickaway Elementary to be purchased from the Federal Emergency Repair Program at a cost of \$27,998.00.
- ❖ Authorizing the Treasurer and Karlsberger to advertise for bids for the remainder of the Pickaway Elementary boiler replacement project (unit vents, pipes, electric, etc.).
- ❖ Employing Trevor Younkin on a two (2) year teaching contract beginning in the 2003-04 school year, salary per the negotiated agreement.
- ❖ Continuing the employment of Trina Hemming as a classified substitute aide for the remainder of the 2002-03 school year in the primary grades to provide intervention assistance at 6 hours per day, 0 experience, with no benefits, to be paid from the Ohio Reads grant.
