WHEREAS, the Logan Elm Local School District Board of Education ("Board") desires to acquire real property for the future expansion of school facilities;

WHEREAS, certain real property [located adjacent to Board property] with parcel number J2400020011500 ("property") consisting of approximately 27.293 acres may be available for purchase;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes the Superintendent and Treasurer with the assistance of legal counsel to negotiate the terms of a sale of the property and/or the right of first refusal with owner or owner's agent, with such sale or right of first refusal to be subject to the final approval of the Board of Education and owner.

- Adopting the following resolution:

WHEREAS a heating oil spill was discovered at the Logan Elm High School on October 11, 2007;

WHEREAS school officials, in consultation with the Ohio EPA, determined that steps needed to be taken immediately to clean up the spilled heating oil from the school facility;

WHEREAS school officials, in consultation with the Ohio EPA, determined that BBU Services, Inc. could provide the necessary services to clean up the spill;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Logan Elm Local School District Board of Education that the Board of Education did not need to follow the procedures for bidding of contracts under Ohio Revised Code Section 3313.46 when engaging the services of BBU Services, Inc. because such services were not for the purpose of building, repairing, enlarging, improving or demolishing a school building;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that to the extent that O.R.C. §3313.46 did apply, there was an urgent necessity to engage BBU Services, Inc. to provide the necessary services to clean up the spill and the bidding procedure under O.R.C. §3313.46 would have unduly slowed down the process to complete the work;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the services provided by BBU Services, Inc.
